The OPP's online record check process validates your identity online. For the majority of applicants, this will take place via Electronic Identity Verification (EIV).

Acceptable forms of Photo ID: Driver's License, BYID, Military Employment Card, Canadian Citizenship Card, Indian Status Card, Passport, Permanent Resident Card, PAL, CNIB Card, Ontario Photo ID Card (MTO), NEXUS Card or FAST Pass.

Acceptable forms of Non-Photo ID: Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate, Hunting License, Outdoors Card, Canadian Blood Donor Card, Immigration Papers

**At least one piece of ID must be photo ID.*

***SIN and Health Cards do not qualify as ID.*

Police reference checks must be done online via www.opp.ca, and navigate to "Police Record Checks".
